Your account will be confirmed and you will be logged in.5. Now, select the course you want to participate in.6. If you are prompted for an "enrollment key" - use the one that your coordinator has given you. This will "enroll" you in the course.7. You can now access the full course. From now on you will only need to enter your personal username and password (in the form on this page) to log in and access any course you have enrolled in. <p><input type="button" value="Create new account"/></p>

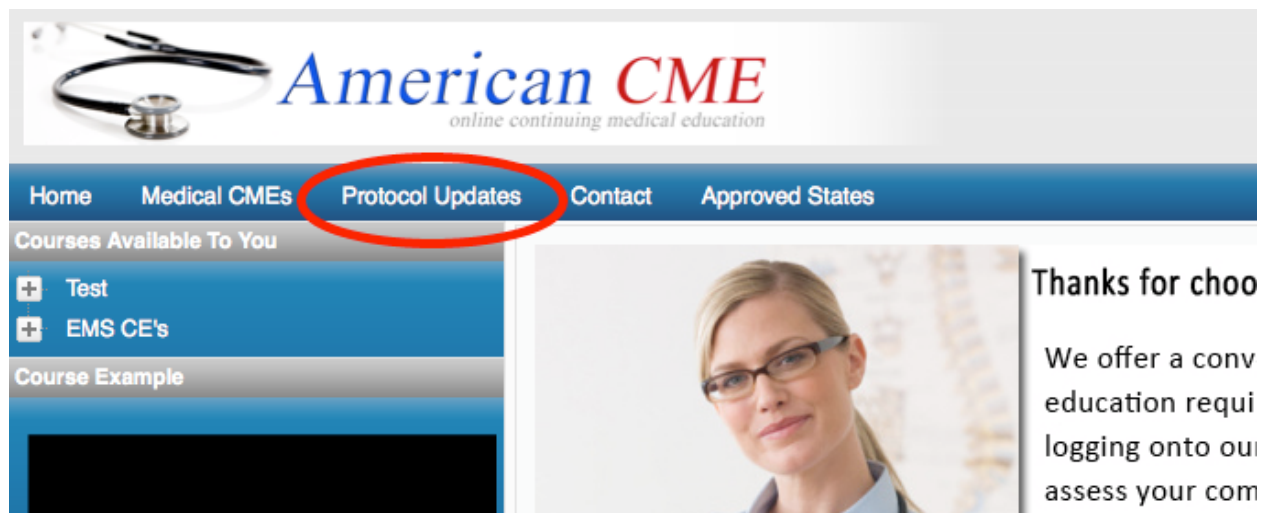
