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Every medication has an approved generic name. Often, it will also have one or more trade names. This can sometimes lead to confusion.

This is a list of the medications in the Southeast Michigan (SEM) Regional Drug Box. We have identified the trade name for COMMONLY CONFUSED medications that are carried by our

Paramedics. **Midazolam** (Versed) and **Ondansetron** (Zofran) are two recent additions to the SEM Regional Drug Box and being familiar of with generic name will reduce the chance for a medical error.

As a safeguard against medical errors please familiarize your Paramedics with this list.
