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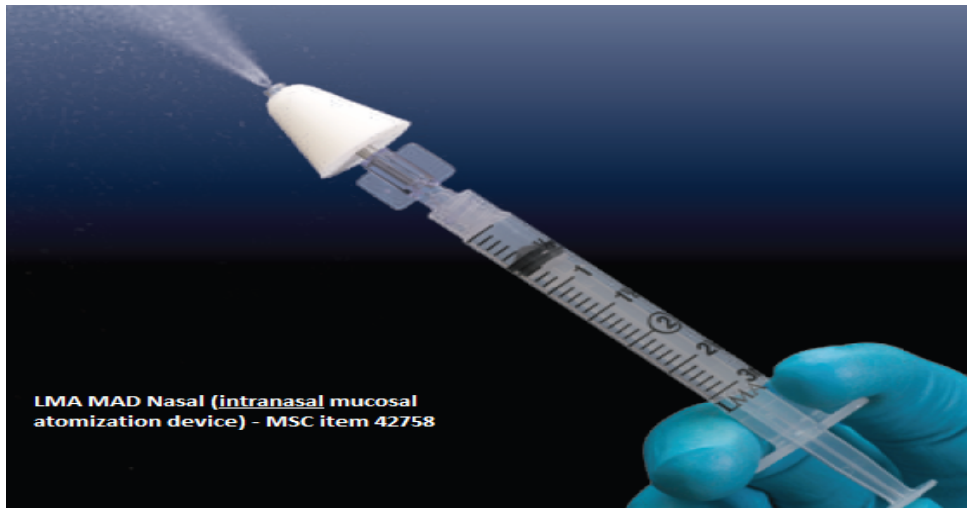
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EMS DRUG BOX CHANGES

On October 2, 2012 minor changes will be occurring to the EMS drug boxes. As always, these will be done as the boxes come in for exchange and noted on the exterior of the box with an updated label. Changes are as follows:

- Dopamine concentration will change from the 400mg/5ml vial to the 200mg/5ml vial. Quantity #2
- Addition of the Laryngeal Mucosal Atomizer Device (LMAD) for nasal administration of Midazolam. Quantity#2
- No changes to the A-pack
