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UPDATE ON COVID-19 EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Emergency Protocols: The only Emergency Protocols currently in effect include:

Protocol 11.01 Personal Protection and Decon

This protocol has NOT changed. If there is a patient involved or a responder is within 6 feet of someone during the commission of a call, they must remain MASKED, regardless of vaccination status. MiOSHA rules have been updated, which allows for FULLY VACCINATED individuals to be unmasked in stations and response vehicles when they are not participating in an EMS response, IF the agency has included that in their COVID-19 plan. The protocol around respiratory protection and PPE will remain in place for the foreseeable future, even with the changes to epidemic orders occurring on July 1st. This decision is intended to keep the responders as safe as possible.

Emergency Protocols 11.04 Clinical Testing and Vaccinating and 11.05 Monoclonal Antibody Administration will remain in effect.
